## Reasons for Good Questions

- 1. Questions serve as a formative assessment to determine the level of understanding of each student.
- 2. We can use questions to create opportunities for students to communicate in meaningful ways related to the content they are studying.
- 3. Good questions can serve as a means to cause students to justify beliefs, responses, and reasoning.
- 4. Questions can cause students to analyze and synthesize, compare and contrast, and evaluate.
- 5. Helping students learn to inquire and problem solve is an essential reason for good questioning.
